A meeting of the AUAB was held yesterday the 19.06.2019. The following comrades were present in the meeting.

Com. Chandeswar Singh, Chairman, AUAB, presided over the meeting. Com. P. Abhimanyu, Convenor presented the agenda for discussion in the meeting.

The ongoing acute financial crisis of BSNL came in for serious discussions. Disconnection of electricity connections in a big way in all the circles, non- payment of bills to contractors & vendors and non- payment of wages of contract workers have seriously affected the quality of services. The Corporate Office has banned all Capital Expenditures (CAPEX). This again is going to affect the services, as a result of which even whatever the Company is earning presently is going to be affected. Wage bill of the employees is Rs.1,300 crore per month and other expenditures come to Rs.900 crore per month. Whereas, the Company's monthly earning is only Rs.1200 crore per month.

After thorough discussions, the following decisions are taken.

- A letter should be written to Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad, Hon'ble MoC & IT, demanding an early meeting to discuss about the financial revival of BSNL.
- 2) Letter should be written to the BSNL Management, demanding immediate withdrawal of the letter, imposing ban on CAPEX.
- 3) As regards the charter of demands, all the existing demands should be emphatically raised. Together with that, immediate financial relief to overcome BSNL's ongoing crisis, as well as financial assistance for long term infrastructure development of BSNL, should be raised. A charter of demands, consisting all these issues, should be submitted to the Hon'ble MoC & IT.
- 4) A meeting should be held with the CMD BSNL immediately, to demand that the issue of imposing break- In- service under FR 17A should be settled.
